A system which is not fit for purpose in small schools, with small primaries being five times more likely to be judged as inadequate compared to larger schools in 23-24. Statistically the one size fits all concept, along with many other things, has to change. I am especially pleased it was recognised that we are in the top 1% of the population for Attendance, Phonics at Year 1 and Reading, Writing and Maths at Year 2 . And, that we have been for many years, is a credit to the pupils, families and the staff. Well done everyone! Our children deserve the best and that is what they get at Cambo! In Northumberland we are so fortunate to have so many nurturing, small schools. As we say at Cambo... We are small in number only! In every other way we are HUGE! So now that the elephant in the room has gone, we can get back to what is important, what is happening at Cambo this term, rather than OFSTED!




